April is Child Abuse Prevention Month

The Archdiocese of Philadelphia (AOP) is committed to protecting our children and providing support to victims of child abuse. Check out the parish website for more from the Archdiocese. www.olguadalupe.org/from-the-pastors-desk/

Zero Tolerance – 100% Committed

The AOP has a *zero tolerance* policy for clergy, lay employees, and volunteers who engage in misconduct or abuse of children and takes *immediate* action when an accusation is made. We are committed to educating all those who work with children, as well as the children in our schools and education programs, on how to recognize improper conduct and abuse and be comfortable enough to report a problem.

- There are over 280 designated Safe Environment Coordinators working in AOP parishes, schools and youth serving ministries to ensure compliance with laws and policies.
- Approximately 110,000 adults have received training to recognize, respond and report child abuse since 2003.
- Over 47,000 adults received mandatory reporter training.
- Over 100,000 children receive age-appropriate abuse prevention education yearly.
- The AOP has invested over \$3.2 million in education and training since 2006.

As part of the Parish Life Center (PLC) security system, the PLC front doors will be locked during parish office hours. The security system that was installed when the PLC was built is now working. Help Our Teens Earn Money and Get to World Youth Day!


