Dear Parishioners,

Over the next several weeks, the parish is going to hold nominations for additional membership on the Parish Pastoral Council. This council is a visioning and planning body of parishioners who foster full participation of the entire parish in the life and mission of the church as lived out in Our Lady of Guadalupe Parish. In consultation with the Pastor, the Pastoral Council actively listens to and identifies the needs and concerns of the people and reviews the parish pastoral plan to respond to these needs. The Pastoral Council also seeks to implement the plan by seeking the involvement of parishioners.

The Pastoral Council's functions are to:

- Serve a three-year term. The council typically meets 5-6 times per year for 2 hours.
- Serve as a forum for open and free dialogue on matters of pastoral concern.
- Seek out diverse backgrounds, viewpoints, and needs of all the people of Our Lady of Guadalupe.
- Maintain and adjust the Mission Statement that will embrace the total life and mission of the Parish.
- Pray for and recommend to the Pastor of Our Lady of Guadalupe, current and future pastoral needs.
- Establish clear and concise practical goals and objectives based on the Mission Statement and evaluate effectiveness in the areas of: divine worship and prayer, teaching and preaching the Word of God, communal witness to the gospel, and charity and service to all.
- Serve as a visible sign of unity for Our Lady of Guadalupe.
- Accept other responsibilities as assigned by the Pastor.

During this election cycle, we will be electing 4 new members. We are seeking parishioners who possess these qualities:

- a desire for spiritual growth in themselves and the Parish
- an enthusiasm about the future direction of the Parish
- a willingness to listen, to speak honestly and to work toward consensus
- the ability to inspire and empower others to delegate
- flexibility and openness with people and ideas

Nominations will take place over the next few weeks, and will conclude on July 12th. Nomination forms will be included in bulletins and after masses over the next few weeks. Nomination forms will be collected after Mass, can be submitted to the parish office, placed in the ballot box in the Narthex or can be emailed to rsvp@olguadalupe.org.

Those identified as nominees will be invited to attend an information night on July 24th. At this session, all nominees will learn about the role of the Pastoral Council. After this evening, all will be asked to reflect and pray on this information and discern whether or not they feel called to this ministry of service and leadership. Elections will be held starting August 11th concluding on September 8th.

- be at least 18 years of age.
