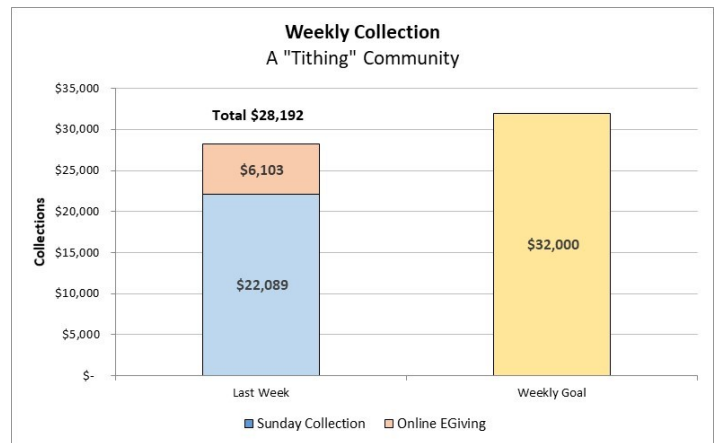

- All people working with children in the AOP, including volunteers, undergo background checks and child abuse clearances.
- All AOP employees and volunteers complete Safe Environment training programs, as well as Mandated Reporter training programs.
- All young people in grades K-12 receive age-appropriate abuse prevention education.
- All AOP employees and volunteers who have contact with children are required to report suspicions of child abuse.

While all the baptized are called to share in the mission of Jesus, those who are ordained also offer service in a way proper to the Sacrament of Holy Orders. A deacon's ministry entails proclaiming, preaching and teaching God's Word, assisting the bishop and priest at the Liturgy, assisting at funerals, ministering to the sick and dying, leading the community in prayer and in sacramental liturgies, baptizing, witnessing marriages, and exercising administrative leadership in the Church. *A permanent deacon, who may be married, is a member of the clergy and shares in the hierarchy of the Sacrament of Holy Orders.* Through the Sacrament of Holy Orders, the deacon is configured to Christ the Servant.

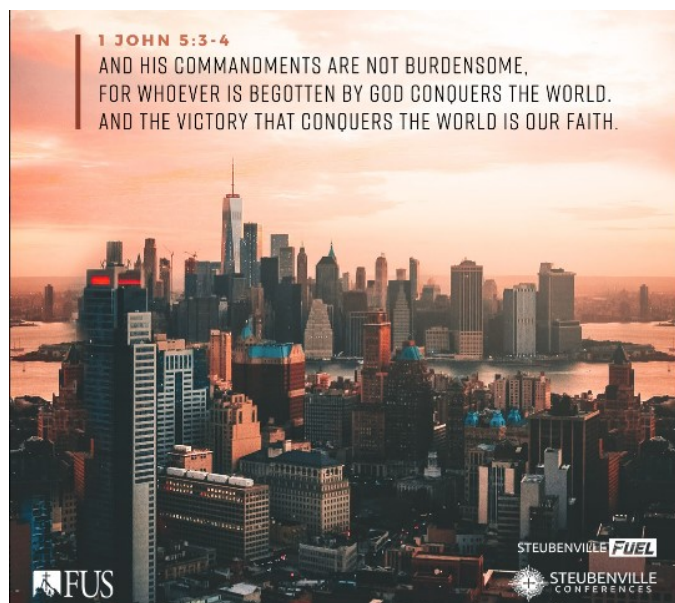


Help Our Teens Earn Money and Get to World Youth Day!
